WATER VALVE The Village of Lynchburg recommends that someone be present when your water service is turned on.

If no one is present, the Village **is not** responsible for any damage caused at your service address.

The Village suggests a shut off valve be installed on your service line where water enters the residence dwelling. The shut off valve at the company's meter setter is for Village use ONLY and is not intended for customer use.

As a onetime courtesy the Village will turn water off &on for maintenance work free of charge. Each additional turn off and turn on will be charged a \$25 each.

In Ohio, all dogs must be supervised and kept physically confined or restrained upon the premises of the owner, or keeper by a leash, tether, adequate fence, or secure enclosure to prevent escape.

After, The Village will be serving a light lunch for Veterans & residents at The Veterans Memorial, located at Agnes Park.









